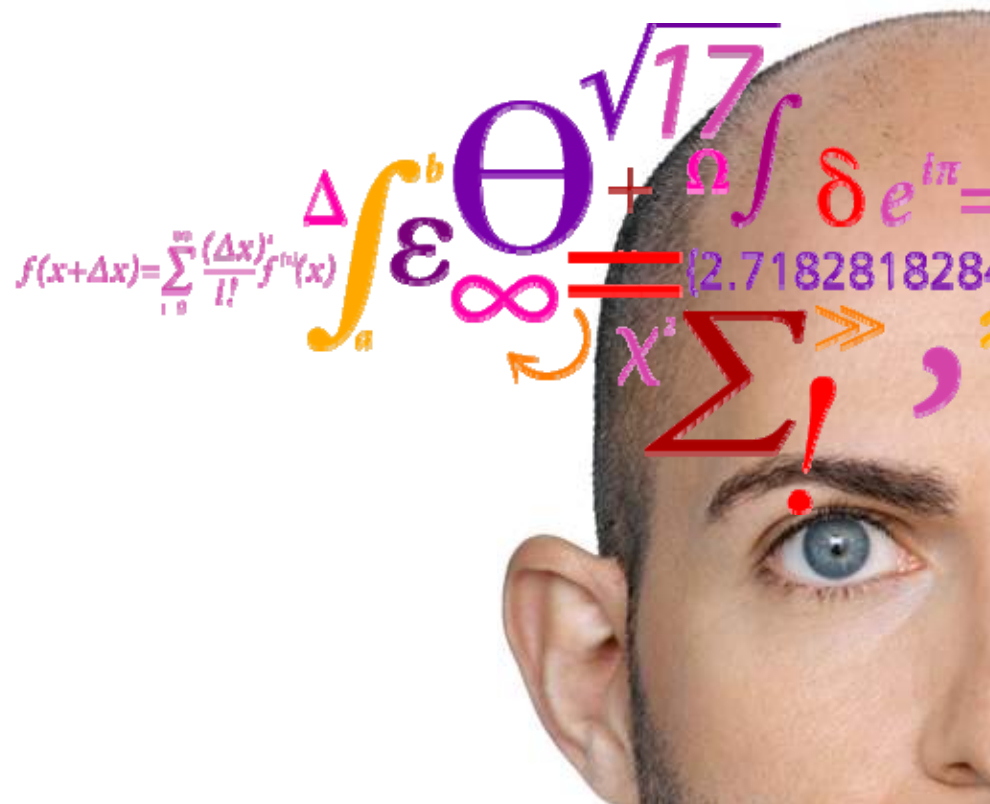

Who can participate?

- All BEng, BSc, and MSc students
- Anyone with a project that contains elements of 'green technology', has been formulated and completed in the period from fall 2010 to spring 2012, and is:
 - a project that has been completed during an existing course
 - a project that has been completed during a special course
 - a bachelor project
 - a thesis


