Lectures will be alternated with project work, panel presentations and debates, and business games, about the following subjects:

- Governance and decision-making within the energy sector
- Policy and governance of complexity
- Megatrends related to the energy and smart grids
- Patterns and dynamics of energy innovation systems
- Greening of innovation
- Entrepreneurial opportunities and how to evaluate them
- Business models for innovation in the energy sector
- How to write a successful business plan for an entrepreneurial idea

The course will offer you a unique opportunity to interact with fellow ambitious students (to a maximum of 40 students) from The Netherlands and Italy. You will be awarded 5 EC for successful completion of the programme. DTU will provide and arrange for travel and accommodation expenses. You are responsible for your dinner and excursion costs.

How to apply

The summer course will take place from the 7th until the 18th of July. In order to apply please submit a letter (max. 500 words) describing your motivation for participation and how this course fits into your master honours programme, or regular master programme. For non-honours programme master students, please also submit a list of you BSc. grades and MSc grades (if available).
