DANFOSS IXA A/S

Danfoss IXA A/S - a new cleantech company spun out from Danfoss in 2009. Danfoss IXA has developed a revolutionary sensor technology.

Danfoss IXA was awarded the Venture Cup prize 2009 for being Denmark’s best cleantech start-up, won 3rd prize the 2009 Global Cleantech Open in Silicon Valley and was nominated for the Climate Cup 2009 innovation prize.
